

**GSO Mark of Conformity
Product Certification- Children Toys**

1. Objective:

This procedure describes the criteria implemented by RACS as Notified Body of GCC Standardization Organization (GSO) to assure that **Children Toys** products intended for certification with GSO are complying the relevant mandatory schemes and applicable Standards.

Furthermore, this document identifies the steps taken by RACS Clients (Manufacturers, Traders, importers, retailers, Business owners or any other client) to get their products/processes certified prior to its commercializing in the market and registered by through RACS Quality Certificates Issuing Services as GSO Notified Body authorized by GSO by issuing certificates of conformity for G-Mark in accordance with Scheme Owner GSO Regulations.

- To ensure that toys in GCC conform to the Gulf Technical Regulations and related approved standards.
- To safeguard the health and safety of the community.

2. Definitions:

- **GSO:** GCC Standardization Organization
- **RACS:** RACS Quality certificates issuing services
- **Scheme:** Certification system related to specified products, to which the same specified requirements, specific rules and procedures apply.
- **Certification:** Third-party attestation related to products, processes, systems or persons.
- **Notified Body:** a conformity assessment body designated by GSO to conduct conformity assessment process on products and processes in accordance with related schemes/standards/regulations mandated by GSO.
- **Conformity Certificate:** Formal document issued by RACS as notified body under approval of GSO stating that certification is being granted for the product/process in accordance with applicable scheme/standards as per GSO Requirements.

3. Responsibility:

It is the responsibility of RACS as GSO Notified Body for G-Mark to establish and maintain the appropriate system to satisfy GSO clients requirements in accordance to the notification system mandated by GSO.

It is the responsibility of GSO clients and RACS clients to provide all needed requirements as per GSO Notified Body for G-Mark to ensure their products compliance to the applicable schemes and standards.

4. Introduction about RACS as Notified to provide Certification:

RACS is approved notified certification Body by GCC Standardization Organization (GSO).

RACS is an authorized conformity assessment body by GAC/SASO that it is technically competent to perform the specific tasks of certification to GAC/SASO clients.

5. Service Type:

As per Scheme owner rules, RACS certifies Children toys (GSO Technical Regulation on Toys: Second Edition - BD-131704-01) and issues Certificate of conformity under:

- **Product Certification:** Technical regulation being implemented by GSO. Issuance of certificate of conformity by RACS as GSO's Notified Body assures the compliance of products/production process with the requirements of the approved schemes, standards and others specified in the technical regulation by the GCC Standardization Organization.

6. Scope of certified products by RACS – GSO Notified Body for G-Mark:

This document cover certifies Children Toys products with below details of Sector, scope of certified products, products categories and applicable type of certification:

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6.1 Regulated Products

The regulation applies to Children toys or toys: Products designed or intended, whether or not exclusively, for use in play by children under 14 years of age.

Products not to be considered as toys:

- Decorative objects for festivities and celebrations.
- Products for collectors, provided that the product or its packaging bears a visible and legible indication that it is intended for collectors of 14 years of age and above. Examples of this category are:
 - a. detailed and faithful scale models;
 - b. kits for the assembly of detailed scale models;
 - c. folk dolls and decorative dolls and other similar articles;
 - d. Historical replicas of toys; and
 - e. Reproductions of real fire arms.
- Sports equipment, including roller skates, inline skates, and skateboards intended for children with a body mass of more than 20 kg.
- Bicycles with a maximum saddle height of more than 435 mm, measured as the vertical distance from the ground to the top of the seat surface, with the seat in a horizontal position and with the seat pillar set to the minimum insertion mark.
- Scooters and other means of transport designed for sport or which are intended to be used for travel on public roads or public pathways.
- Electrically driven vehicles which are intended to be used for travel on public roads, public pathways, or the pavement thereof.
- Aquatic equipment intended to be used in deep water and swimming learning devices for children, such as swim seats and swimming aids.
- Puzzles with more than 500 pieces.
- Guns and pistols using compressed gas, with the exception of water guns and water pistols, and bows for archery over 120 cm long.
- Fireworks, including percussion caps which are not specifically designed for toys.
- Products and games using sharp-pointed missiles, such as sets of darts with metallic points.
- Functional educational products, such as electric ovens, irons or other functional products operated at a nominal voltage exceeding 24 volts which are sold exclusively for teaching purposes under adult supervision.
- Products intended for use for educational purposes in schools and other pedagogical contexts under the surveillance of adults.
- Electronic equipment, such as personal computers and game consoles, used to access interactive software and their associated peripherals, unless the electronic equipment or the associated peripherals are specifically designed for and targeted at children and have a play value on their own, such as specially designed personal computers, key boards, joy sticks or steering wheels.
- Interactive software, intended for leisure and entertainment, such as computer games, and their storage media, such as CDs.
- Babies' soothers.
- Child-appealing luminaires.
- Electrical transformers for toys.
- Fashion accessories for children which are not for use in play.

This Regulation shall not apply to the following toys:

- a. Playground equipment intended for public use;
- b. Automatic playing machines, whether coin operated or not, intended for public use;
- c. Toy vehicles equipped with combustion engines;

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- d. Toy steam engines; and
- e. Slings and catapults.

6.2 Toys grouping

Several different toys (models, SKUs) can fall under the same GCTS. All SKUs within a group need to meet the relevant criteria as follow:

- a. In general, the followings principles of toys grouping are admitted:
 - i. Same HS code
 - ii. Similar age range (0 to 36 months, 3 years to 8 years, over 8)
 - iii. Same manufacturer as defined in Article 1.25 of the GCC technical regulation on Children Toys.
 - iv. Same manufacturer may sell the same toy using different brand names.
- b. There is no limit for the number of different SKUs per group.
- c. Notwithstanding the general principle in par. (a) above, Toys categorization proposal, excel sheet on 7th May 2019 - The main categories tab - (copy attached) is to be considered, and further improvement can be realized in future updates of this document.
- d. Toys from factories of same supplier in same country can be grouped, while toys from different suppliers can't be grouped.

6.3 Representative Tests

- a. Test reports have to cover relevant hazards for toys categories as per 2.a.
- b. at least 1 SKU and a maximum 6 of the SKUs falling under the same group (for group with less than 60 SKUs).
- c. 5% to 10% of the SKUs falling under the same group in all cases.
- d. New products can be added to an existing group if they fulfil the criteria for that group (toy type, age, classification and type of hazards as per point 1).
- e. Possibility for manufacturers to add new SKUs to an initial certified group, and certificate to be amended bearing in mind the criteria defined above.

6.4 Mandatory vs Non-mandatory Tests

- a. Toys excel sheet on 7th May 2019 - The main categories tab - shall be relevant, and further improvement can be realized in future updates of the document.
- b. A particular process for updating is to be documented taking into account the important aspects such as products not considered or grey area.
- c. For aspects such as (PAH, BPA) covered under (BD130704-01, Annex II, Part III, Par. 3 and Annex VIII), a specific procedure Risk assessment based is to be conducted for the initial period before having detailed criteria and procedures on the relevant implementation of this requirement.

7. Mandatory Schemes and Applicable Standards:

GSO Technical Regulation on Toys: Second Edition - BD-131704-01

If needed, Client refers to RACS to identify applicable Scheme and Standards.

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RACS Staff to refer to RACS/REC/79 Scope of Certified Products by RACS to identify Certification Applicable schemes and standards.

8. Requirements for Certification:

Requirements varies depending on the scope of certified products; Details of the documents required for certification for the scope of Children Toys Product as per Scheme Owner (GSO – G-Mark Certification) requirements are detailed as following:

- 8.1. Application form & Supportive documents:** Application form aligns all requirements of the specific standard to which client wishes to be certified and which must be submitted as following:

Product Certification:

1. Application form
2. Valid Industry/Trade License (For Companies within UAE).
3. Declaration of Conformity by the Applicant on the Product(s) for Registration using the Applicant's Official Letterhead.
4. Test Reports (from Third Party Accredited Laboratories and within three years from the date of application).
5. ISO/Government Accreditation or Notified Bodies used EN Standards for tests.
6. Product Identity Declaration Form.
7. Written Declaration that the same application has not been lodged with any other Notified Body.
8. Technical File (refer to BD131704-01)

For Manufacturers: -a general description of toys; - a detailed description with conceptual design and manufacturing drawings, including a list of components, materials, sub-assemblies and circuits used in the toy as well as the safety data sheets on chemicals used, to be obtained from the chemical suppliers; - descriptions and explanations necessary for the understanding of those drawings and schemes and the operation of toys; - the addresses of the places of manufacture and storage; - a list of the Gulf standards applied in full or in part, and descriptions of the solutions adopted to meet the essential requirements of the Gulf technical regulations in force where those Gulf standards have not been applied. In the event of partly applied Gulf standards, the technical documentation shall specify the parts which have been applied; - results of design calculations made, examinations carried out, etc.; - a description of the conformity assessment procedure followed and test reports. For Importers: - A general description of toys; - Test reports carried out pursuant to paragraphs 3 and 4 of this annex.

- o **Application for Certification (Application Form):** Application to be filled by the client will contain all the necessary information needed by RACS Quality for conducting the certification Process, such important information is:
 - Type of Product to be certified: Product to identify the related scheme implemented by GSO.
 - Relevant standard/ or normative documents clients is seeking certification for.
 - General information: Applicant Business activities & related business facilities & relationship between their facilities, in relevance to the certification scheme applied for information about outsourced Processes relevant to Product conformity.
 - Any other information needed related to certification requirements.
By signing the application form, the applicant and the manufacturer agrees to comply with these General Rules and with the Specific Product Standard for the product covered by Registration / CB Certification

8.2. Legal Agreements:

- Certification Agreement:
- Non-Disclosure Agreement
- General Conditions for Certification Services (only signed 1 time by the client)

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8.3. **Fees** as detailed in RACS Schedule of Fees (RACS/REC/46)

9. Certification Procedures:

Based on its role as GSO G-Mark Notified Body, Procedure will be performed as following:

9.1. Preparatory Steps:

- 9.1.1. Application Form shall be submitted by applicant to RACS, submission can be done via RACS affordable communication methods (mail, emails, hard copy, website, E-System)
- 9.1.2. Sales and Marketing Executive/Administrative assistant will review it to check documents availability on a primary basis
- 9.1.3. A quotation will be sent to applicant by Head of Sales and Marketing Department; containing the scope of certification and fees related to each step of the certification process.
- 9.1.4. Payment shall be done by applicant.

9.2. Application Review

- 9.2.1. Upon acceptance of quotation by client, he is requested to Sign the Certification agreement.
- 9.2.2. Application along with related supportive documents will be received by RACS Conformity Manager who shall assign one of RACS technical team members (Conformity Officer- (Evaluator or Auditor).

9.3. Application Evaluation

- 9.3.1. Conformity Officer (Evaluator or Auditor) shall perform conformity assessment (Evaluation) steps related to the certification scheme (Product Certification):

Product Certification

- Detailed documents review for all the documents
 - Document review includes the check up for Test Reports parameters and results, done by 3rd party Laboratory according to the specific technical regulations and applicable standards.
 - Evaluation of product the eligibility of the Product for certification to assure compliance according to applicable schemes and standards
- 9.3.2. Evaluation Outcome results:
- If evaluation is pending for missing or invalid documents or other needed information to complete evaluation; Additional Supportive Documents will be requested by Applicant.
 - Evaluation includes Product Safety Verification through test reports provided on all safety Test parameters requested by applicable scheme/standards, test reports shall be issued by 3rd party accredited Laboratory sub-contracted according to the approved Standards and applicable technical requirements.
 - If test reports are not complying with Standards; Conformity Officer/Assessor requests rectification of the non-complying aspects, then based on applicant confirmation of rectification, Collection of samples will be done to conduct the same laboratory tests again and for once.
 - Evaluation will be repeated upon applicant re-submission of needed documents/information.

- 9.4. **Decision of Certification:** Upon submission of this information, and as per the result of documents review and completing product evaluation process,

- 9.4.1. Recommendation of approval of Product certification: Product evaluation shows full compliance with applicable schemes/standards:

- Application is initially approved by Conformity Officer/Assessor
- Recommendation for certification approval will be made by Conformity Manager or his delegates
- Certification decision will be done by Decision Committee
- Granting the issuance of Certificate of conformity, recognized by scheme owner (GSO)
- Certified Products will be listed in RACS Certified Products registry.

- 9.4.2. Recommendation of rejection of Product certification: Product evaluation shows non-compliance with applicable schemes/standards, due to any reason preventing product from Certification:

- Application is declined by Conformity Officer/Assessor
- Recommendation for certification rejection will be made by Conformity Manager or his delegates
- Rejection decision will be done by Decision Committee
- RACS will inform client by an Official rejection statement (Letter of certification Status) by e-mail stating the reason of rejection.

10. GSO Conformity Tracking Symbol (GCTS) for Products

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GCTS for products are intended for competent authorities in GSO member states to check the validity of the relevant certificate at the first port of entry in the GCC common market. The validity of current GCTS for products is bound to the certificate validity and maintenance; therefore, it cannot be used to track the products during all their transfers and life on the market. Nonetheless, consumers and other interested parties are able to access the overview of the product verification online at any time.


10.1 Configuration (new GCTS for products active starting from April 2019)

The GCTS for Products is composed by two elements as shown in Fig. 1:

10.1.1 Gulf Conformity Marking (G-Mark logo): 

10.1.2 The QR Code tracking the product: 

*NOTE:
For rules of transition from the previous configuration of the GCTS for products (including the ID number of the Notified Body issuing the certificate beneath the Gulf Conformity Marking logo) see Foreword.*

10.2 Location

10.2.1 When required by the GSO Regulation(s) that are applicable to the product, the GCTS for products shall be affixed on the product body, the rating plate or product marking label; when the rating plate or label do not allow the addition of the GCTS for lack of space, it is allowed to affix the GCTS on the product body itself.

In any case, the GCTS shall be visible on the outside surface or under an easily accessible part, which means a part that can be accessed without the use of a tool (for example a removable cover or a door).

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NOTE:

This requirement applies to the main body of the product and not to additional parts and accessories that might be added to the main body. For products formed by two or more main functional units identified by their independent plates, the GCTS shall be put on all units.


10.2.2 The GCTS for products shall also be affixed to the product packaging; in case there's more than one level of packaging the GCTS shall be affixed on all levels to be readily available for surveillance.

NOTE:

- *This requirement applies to the packaging of the main body of the product and not to additional parts and accessories that might be packed in separate packages/boxes.*
- *Shipping cartons used to package multiple units of the same or different products during transport or storage may not bear the GCTS, but the manufacturer may affix the marking on the cartons on voluntary basis for easier tracking.*

10.2.3 When the dimensions and/or nature of the product do not allow to affix the GCTS as defined in the requirement of clause 10.2.1, the GC marking (G-Mark logo) alone is acceptable; if this is not possible, the complete GCTS on the packaging alone is enough.

10.2.4 GC marking (G-Mark logo) or complete GCTS for products can be put on the instruction manual accompanying the products on a voluntary basis.

10.3 Dimensions and color settings

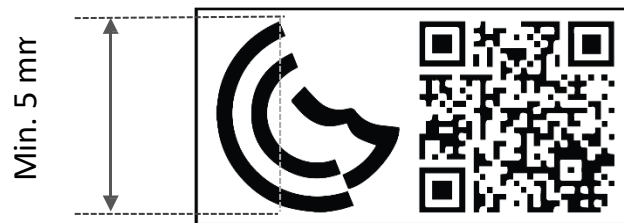
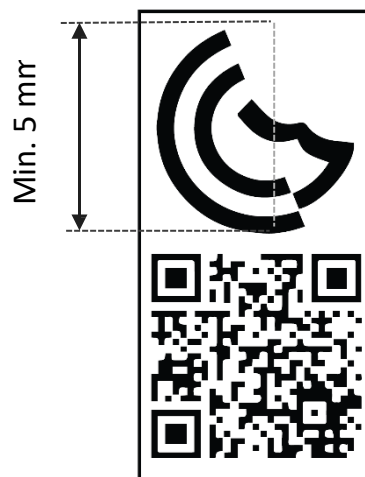


Fig. 2a: GCTS for products, horizontal layout

10.3.1 The GCTS for products shall meet the minimum dimensions as shown in Fig. 2a and 2b:

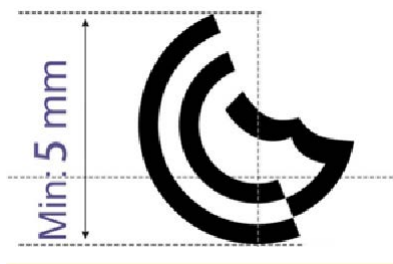


Fig. 3: GC Marking, minimum dimensions

10.3.2 The Gulf Conformity (GC) marking forming part of the GCTS for products shall be in accordance with the requirements of the relevant Gulf Technical Regulation for conformity marking for the GCC Countries "BD09100501", and shall have a minimum height of 5 mm as shown in Fig. 3:

10.3.3 Provided that the minimum dimensions are respected the GCTS may be enlarged, but proportions shall be maintained.

10.3.4 The elements of the GCTS for products shall be considered as a single entity for purposes of enlargement or reduction as shown in Figure 4.

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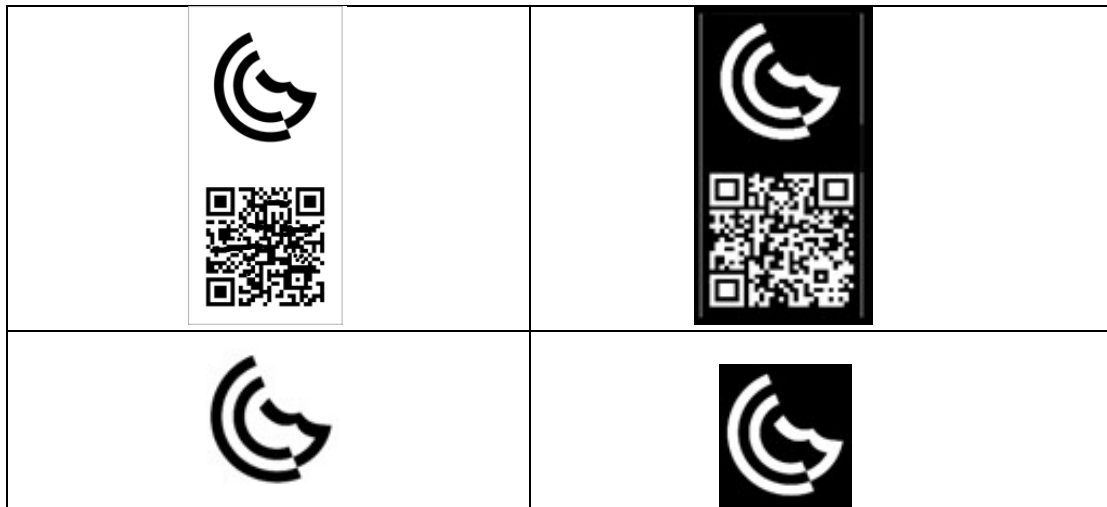


Fig 5-a: - (GCTS) positive and negative versions

10.3.5 GCTS may be reproduced in either black and white or in a color scheme providing enough contrast to ensure the QR code can be scanned, as detailed in this document. Alternatively, the GSO conformity tracking symbol may be printed or displayed in a single color, which is the predominant ink color, or in the case of a pre-printed packaging, the predominant ink color of the packaging, or the use of another single color, as shown in Fig 5-a and Fig 5-b.

11. Use of the GCTS for Products

11.1 General Conditions

11.1.1 GCTS in accordance with clauses 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 shall be visible, legible, permanent (indelible and/or not easy to remove) and readable by a scanner or reader application of a smartphone.

11.1.2 Before putting products in the GCC market, the GCTS of product shall be linked to a valid and active certificate under the GSO Scheme. Following the certificate issuance and its approval by GSO, the GCTS of product shall be supplied by the Notified Body to the Economic Operator in electronic versions obtained from the GSO certificate tracking system.

11.1.3 GCTS shall not be used in conjunction with the logo/mark of the notified body, or the logo/mark of the manufacturer, or any other picture or logo that could be misleading. No other images or writings shall be overlapping with the GCTS or compromise its visibility and readability.

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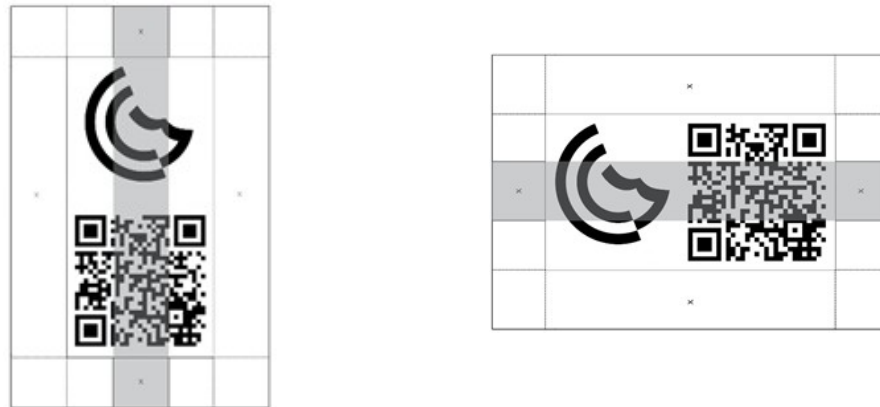


Fig 6: - (GCTS) clear space

11.1.4 GCTS for products shall be affixed on each manufactured unit under the sole responsibility of Certificate holder; Notified Bodies provide the Certificate holder with the GCTS for products and inform him about their correct placement and use, as stipulated in this document.

11.1.5 GCTS shall not be used in such a way to mislead or falsify conformity in any manner.

11.1.6 Any use of the GCTS that might contravene the conditions of use laid down in this document shall be referred immediately to GSO.

11.1.7 GCTS shall not be used in such a way as to imply that the GSO accepts responsibility for activities carried out under the scope of the Notified Body or the obligations of the Economic Operator.

11.1.8 Where the GCTS is reproduced electronically the user shall ensure that infilling does not occur and degradation and/or distortion of GCTS graphic is avoided.

11.2 Suspension, Withdrawal, Termination, Expiry of Certificates.

11.2.1 When the certificate covering the products marked with the GCTS is suspended or withdrawn by the Notified Body the economic operator shall immediately cease to use the GCTS.

11.2.2 In case of suspension, the GCTS may be used again only when the Notified Body confirms in writing that all the issues are resolved, and the certificate has been re-activated.

11.2.3 In case of withdrawal, termination or expiry of the certificate the certificate holder shall immediately cease to use the relevant GCTS until a new certificate is issued and approved by the Notified Body.

12. Renewal:

Product Certification:

- Validity of certificate is 5 years.
- COC should be renewed 2 months prior expiry
